Instructions for International Junior Conference entitled Where the World is Heading 2022

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1. The main organizer of the International Junior Conference entitled Where the World is Heading 2021 is the Sopot Science Association in cooperation with Institute of Oceanology Polish Academy of Sciences, Today We Have, MSC and the Gdynia Aquarium NMFRI.

1.2. Junior Conference entitled Where the World is Heading 2021 will take place on June 9, 2022.

1.3. The conference is intended for primary and secondary school students who are interested in maritime issues, are willing to present their projects, actions in the oceanic context and climate change, which they have organized in their local environment (school, housing estate, city, etc.).

1.4. The authors of the best projects presented at the International Junior Conference entitled Where the World is Heading 2021 will be awarded. Participation in the International Junior Conference entitled Where the World is Heading 2022 will be confirmed with a diploma of participation.

1.5. Each participating group may count up to 6 participants, except for grades 1-3, where the project may be prepared by the whole class. Age groups are: 7-9, 10-12; 13-15; 16-18. We reserve the right to change age groups depending on the number of applications in individual age groups.

3.3. You can send 1 movie up to 3 minutes long, 1 presentation up to 10 slides with description in the language Polish and English (max 1 A4 page, Times 11, about 2000 characters).

3.4. Subtitles in English must be included in the uploaded video.

3.5. During the conference, the qualified groups will have the opportunity to present themselves project in English (3 minutes + 2 minutes for questions).
